

For several days, someone in a central Texas town tried to give away a litter of puppies. Shortly afterward, little Alice was found lying on the parking lot of an auto parts store. She had been stabbed multiple times, and most of one ear had been slashed off! "Yes," was our response to a frantic call for help, and Alice arrived in Abilene a few hours later. Near death, Alice made a dramatic recovery. All the other puppies disappeared. We can't imagine how she escaped.

One of our donors was greatly touched by Alice's story and realizing the large number of emergency medical cases we handle, has offered to match all our donations up to \$45,000.

highway. Three were hit and killed before one of our


partners was able to corral them and send them to Abilene. Highly adoptable, they all left within two days
